ABOUT THE TALK:

Road safety presents a significant challenge in India, with an annual toll of over 1.5 lakh fatalities and a considerably higher number of injuries, predominantly affecting individuals in their prime years of productivity. Urgent action is imperative to enhance the current road safety scenario. Various approaches can be employed to tackle this problem, and this discussion will centre around crash analysis, mitigation measures and the safe system approach. Crash analysis serves as a reactive method, addressing safety deficiencies after incidents occur. Remedial measures are then implemented to rectify these shortcomings. On the other hand, the safe system approach aims to eradicate fatal and serious injuries among all road users. This approach adopts a comprehensive perspective on the road network, proactively anticipating human errors and minimizing the resultant impact on individuals well-being to manageable levels. The talk will explain the five key components of the safe system approach: ensuring safe road users, safe vehicles, safe speeds, safe roads and post-crash care.
